

SUSTAINABILITY AT OUR HOTEL

OVERVIEW

- Partnership with Batiquitos Lagoon Trail & Foundation
- Electric Charging Stations
- Electric golf carts
- \$6 million investment to preserve and protect the golf course for years to come
- Replaced the golf course grass, reducing water use by approximately 20 percent
- Housekeeping Service Opt-Out program for group and business traveler guests
- Culinary and Food & Beverage partnership sustainability initiatives

CLIMATE CHANGE & WATER

- Retro commissioned automation system, which senses guestroom occupancy to ensure thermostats are only active when guests are present
- Guests staying with us can forgo daily housekeeping service for the duration of their stay, helping conserve water, energy, and cleaning product usage
- Over 85% of interior lightbulbs are energy efficient. Energy efficient lightbulbs include compact fluorescent (CFL), LED, and T5/T8 fluorescent bulbs
- Fully integrated Lutron Grafix 6000 Lighting Control System for all public areas and meeting spaces on a programmable lighting schedule
- All the exterior landscape lights on time clock or photocell to manage energy draws
- Occupancy sensors for lighting in back of house to ensure lights are only active when persons are present
- Through our Conserve program, we change linens every third day unless requested otherwise, and guests may choose to reuse towels by leaving them hanging
- Our daily operational reports are used to effectively schedule heating and cooling needs
- Lights are turned on in meeting rooms only when needed
- Suggesting lower impact options for centerpieces and décor, such as potted plants rather than flower arrangements

WASTE & CIRCULARITY

- Plastic straws are not used
- All paper and plastics are migrating towards 100% compostable
- Hydration stations are available for guests who wish to refill water bottles
- All food waste that is non recyclable is isolated into composting bins
- All recyclable food waste is donated to local food banks
- All recyclables are separated from waste and picked up bi-weekly
- Mobile Entry is available through the World of Hyatt app, which reduced the number of plastic keycards handed out
- Supporting digital signage and offering Hyatt Apps to help enable a paperless meeting
- Offering reports through the Planner Portal, reducing the need to print on paper
- In addition to not replacing used towels when placed on guestroom hooks, damaged linen is donated and damaged towels are treated and recycled to be used as cleaning rags
